

AUTHORIZATION FOR SALE OF CHOMETZ

I, ______, hereby authorize Rabbi Ari Spiegler, of the Beachwood Kehilla, to act as my Shaliach (representative) and empower him (or any agent operating on his behalf) to sell my chometz effective Monday, April 22, 2024, (except for any chometz which will be used prior to 12:04 p.m., Monday, April 22, 2024), in accordance with the prevalent Jewish custom, as he sees fit. (The term chometz is understood according to the Rabbinic definition of leavened food and is to include all types of such food or liquids in pure or mixed forms. It does not include cooking utensils and/or dishes).

The said Chometz is now at the following addresses and locations: (list addresses and specific locations within rooms, if possible, i.e., taped kitchen cabinets, pantry marked for chometz, etc.)

The chometz that I own at all these locations, as well as all other chometz to which I hold ownership title, including transit goods, or goods that would be delivered to me during the period from Monday, April 22, 2024, through Tuesday, April 30, 2024, shall be included in this authorization. This authorization also includes provision for chometz, which I own through shares of stock in corporations, which own chometz. The said chometz is to be sold to a non-Jew during the time period legally allotted to the sale of chometz. The buyer has free access to the chometz acquired by him. The place where the chometz is located is to be rented to the buyer for the period of Monday, April 22, 2024, through Tuesday, April 30, 2024.

The exact assessment of quantity and value will take place after Passover, or in accordance with any arrangements made by Rabbi Spiegler.
